


SAS for Windows Installation Instructions

This page provides instructions on how to download and begin the installation for SAS Order Number 9CB5JG on the platforms listed below:



To Download and begin the SAS installation:


1. Create a new folder on your computer's desktop named SAS in which to save the SAS installer.
 2. Download the [full version of SAS](#) and the latest [SAS license file](#).
- The file size is **26 Gigabytes**. Average **download time** is about **1.5 hours** if you are **off-campus**, depending on your internet connection speed, and about **1 hour** when using an **on-campus** Ethernet connection.




- Once the installer has been downloaded, you can use Winzip or 7-Zip to extract the five disk images from the compressed file. 7-Zip is open-source software and can be downloaded for free at: <https://www.7-zip.org/>
- Using Winzip or 7-Zip, extract the files into the SAS folder you just created on your desktop.




- After the extraction process is complete you will see the following five disk folders in your SAS folder.




- These are the images ISO of the DVDs that you will use for your SAS installation. The files are large so the extraction process could take up to 40 minutes or more. Please note that although there are 5 DVDs shown in the example there are actually 8 DVDs included with this order number.
- When the extraction is complete, double-click the file that ends with **d1** to view its contents.
 - Right-click the **Setup.exe** command and select **Run As Administrator**



7. Follow the on-screen prompts to install SAS and perform any customizations to your installation.



8. When the setup program asks for the next disk, click **Browse** and select the folder in the SAS folder you created whose name has the appropriate disk number (d1, d2, d3, etc.).



9. When the installation is complete, click **Finish**.
