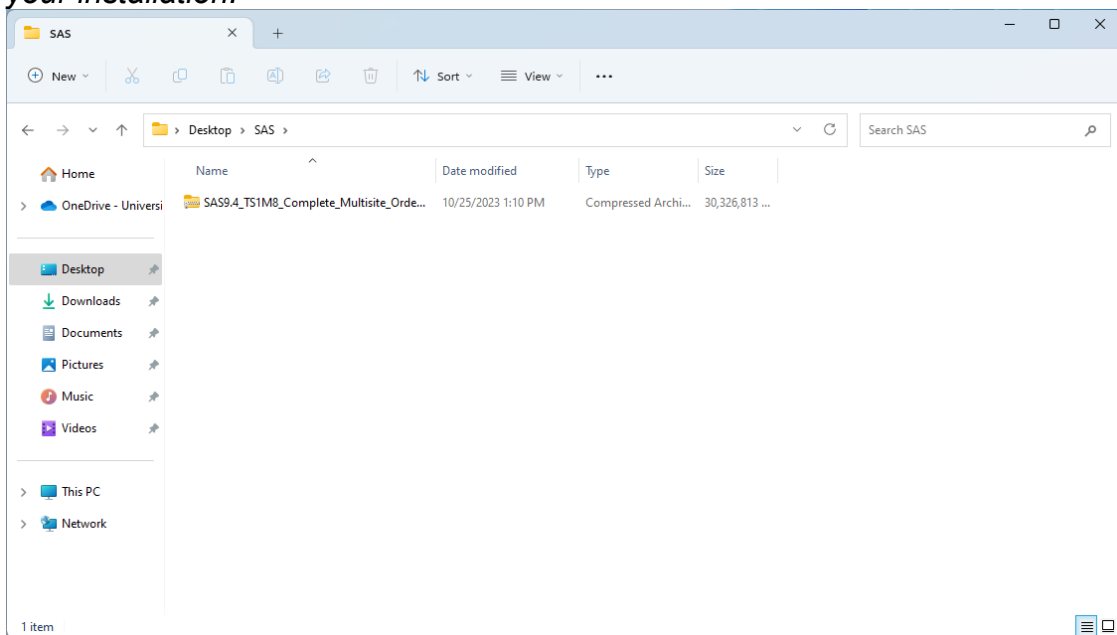


SAS for Windows Installation Instructions

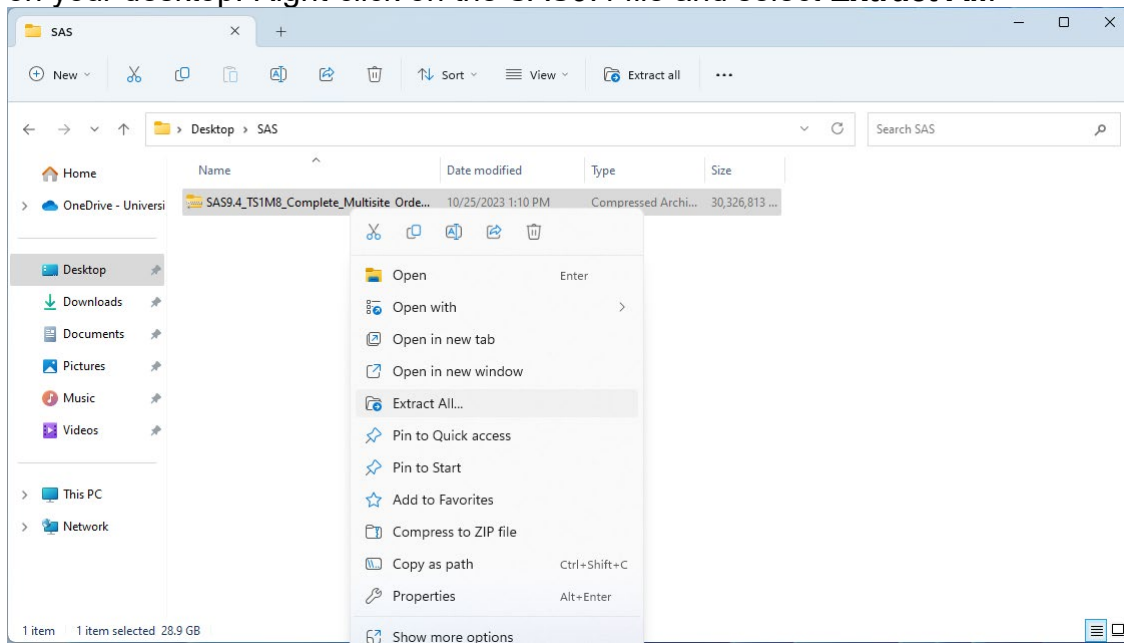
This page provides instructions on how to download and begin the installation for SAS Order Number 9CW32G,

To Download and Install SAS for Windows:

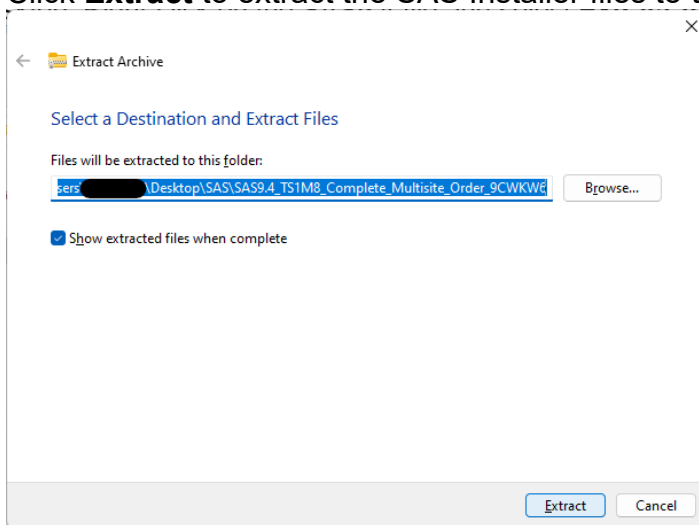
1. Create a new folder on your computer's desktop named SAS in which to save the SAS installer.
 2. Download the [full version of SAS](#) and the latest [SAS license file](#).
- The file size is **28.9 Gigabytes**. Average **download time** is **about 2 hours** if you are **off-campus**, depending on your internet connection speed, and about **40 minutes** when using an **on-campus** Ethernet connection.
 - *PLEASE NOTE that the example file names in the screen shots may differ from those in your installation.*



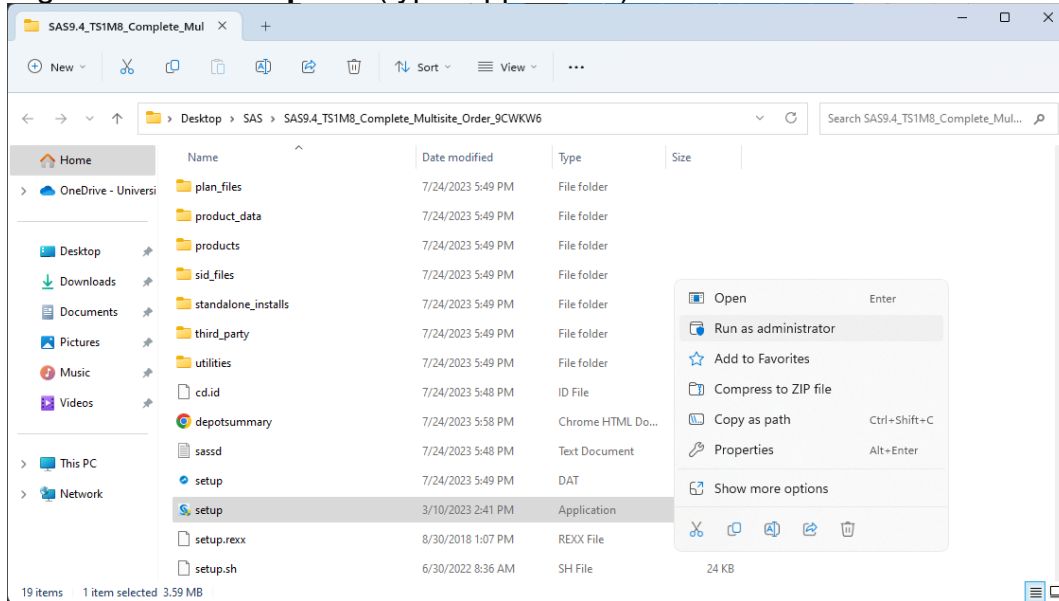
- Once the installer has been downloaded, extract the files into the SAS folder you just created on your desktop. Right-click on the SAS9.4 file and select **Extract All**.



- Click **Extract** to extract the SAS Installer files to the same folder you had created.



4. Right-click the **Setup.exe** (type: application) command and select **Run as administrator**.



5. Follow the on-screen prompts to install SAS and perform any customizations to your installation.

Please note: The SAS installer may report that the imbedded license file is expired. If this happens please go to the **Renewing Your SAS License** section on the SAS download page and download the latest SAS license file (for your Tech Support Site Number) to your desktop. When SAS prompts for a new license you can browse to the license file that you just downloaded.
